- Children must respect authority, peers, and property.
- Children must be able to dress themselves with minimal assistance.
- Children must be able to verbalize their needs and wants clearly.
- Children must be able to sit attentively and quietly for twenty minutes story/circle time.
- Children must demonstrate good listening skills during circle, story or group times.
- Children should recognize their first names in writing.
- Children must know and respond to their first and last names.
- Children should be able to count to ten.
- Children should be able to recite the alphabet.
- Children should be able to recognize some of the letter sounds.
- Children should be able to recognize basic shapes (circle, square, rectangle and triangle).
- Children should know all basic colors (red, yellow, blue, orange, green, purple, brown, black and white).
- Children should be able to hold a pencil correctly.
- Children should be able to hold scissors correctly.
- Children should be able to orient a book. (front-back/top-bottom)
- Children should be able to respond to literature through drawing.
- Children should be able to share with classmates.
