### RESOURCE AND BOOK FEE

### PROGRESS REPORTS AND ASSESSMENTS

Kindergarten, First and Second Grade progress reports, NWEA test results, and preschool assessments will be sent home September 18<sup>th</sup>. Our students have been working hard. Students have settled into a routine. If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to contact your child's teacher.

### ILLNESS

It is that time of year that so many friends don't feel well. Please remember the following:

- **FEVER**—Must be fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication
- **DIARRHEA**- Must stay home if two watery stools in 24 hour period. May return if no diarrhea within 24 hours.
- **VOMITTING**—Home until vomiting stops. May return after 24 hour of no vomiting.

If your child had any symptoms of illness during the night (e.g. nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or fever), you must keep him/her home for at least 24 hours after symptoms are gone and temperature has returned to normal, without the use of medication.

We encourage hand washing and we sanitize throughout the school to be proactive in keeping our students, staff and families healthy.
